## A. Reference Materials

The jurisdictional entity in which the Public Fire Educator serves must have access to the following training manuals:

B. The Certification Program offers two levels of Public Fire Educator Certification:

Processing fees are set at twenty dollars (\$20.00) for each level.

## 1. Public Fire Educator I

- a. Minimum Requirements
  - Applicants must complete one (1) of the following:
    - a) Public Fire Educator I coursework meeting the requirements of NFPA 1035; or
  - b) TEEX Public Fire Educator I course.

## 2. Public Fire Educator II

- a. Minimum Requirements
  - i. Applicants must complete one (1) of the following:
    - a) Public Fire Educator II coursework meeting the requirements of NFPA 1035; orb) TEEX Public Fire Educator II course.
  - ii. Applicants must hold, or apply concurrently for, the following SFFMA certification:a) Public Fire Educator I
